Panorama tour through Wachau Valley

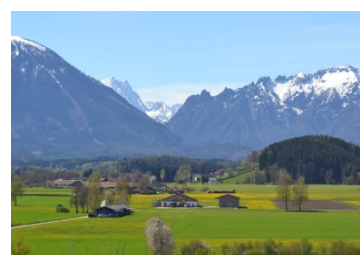
- The Wachau is considered one of the most enchanting stretches of river valley in Europe

Visit Beethoven Pasqualatihaus

- Ludwig van Beethoven worked in Vienna for thirty-five years. Thereof he spent eight years living in this apartment on the fourth floor. The spectacular view over the then still undeveloped site of the fortification approaches towards the northern and north-western suburbs of Vienna kept drawing the composer back to Mölker Bastei after his various short stays in the country.

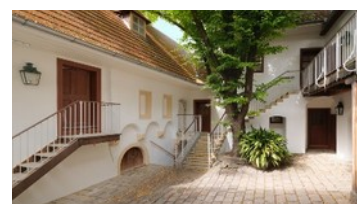
VIENNA

Guided City Tour of Heiligenstadt including Beethoven related sights

- Start your guided city tour of Heiligenstadt including the Beethoven Testament House and the Beethovengang. (Entrances included).

Visit Testament House

- The life and work of Ludwig van Beethoven are inseparably bound up with Vienna. In 1787, the composer first came to the city to study with Mozart; from 1792 onwards he lived permanently here. Three apartments associated with Beethoven have long since featured among Wien Museum's sites.



Visit Beethoven Eroicahaus

- Beethoven enjoyed spending the summer months in the country, frequently in the wine-growing villages to the north-west of Vienna. In 1803, the year he worked primarily on his third symphony, the "Eroica", tradition has it that he spent the summer months in idyllic Oberdöbling.



Take a nice walk down the Beethovengang and see the beautiful nature of Vienna's Kahlenberg

Dinner at a typical Viennese "Heuriger" Restaurant

Visit the Viennese Central Cemetery (Beethoven's grave)

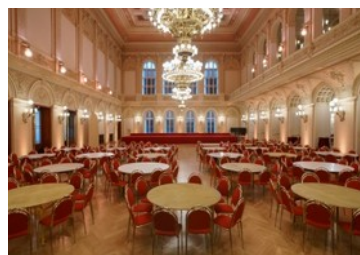
